I am directed to say that Colombo Plan Staff Collage for Technician Education (CPSC), Manila is a specialized agency of the Colombo Plan of which India is a Member – Country. CPSC, Manila in collaboration with the Council for Technical Education and Vocational Training (CTEVT), Kathmandu is organizing a Collaborative Regional Program on "Total Quality Management for TVET Institution" March 29 to April 2, 2010, Pokhara, Nepal.

2. The Program will be focused on TQM structured system, continuous improvement and development of quality culture in TVET institutions. The program aims to take up quality principles to be applied appropriately and effectively in various TVET Institutions in the region. The program also aims to contribute to the raising of awareness on different quality assurance measures and to the provisions of skills and values necessary to put Quality Culture in TVET into practice. This regional program is founded on the premise that specific approaches are needed to deal with the emerging challenges in meeting the regional and global needs of today and in the near future.

3. The program is designed for TVET policy makers, faculty members, and administrators of TVET System. In this regard, they have invited to nominate two (2) applicant's from our country to officially represent our Government in the above program by 26 February, 2010.

4. The participants of the program are required to prepare a country paper based on the thematic areas of program. The guidelines for preparing country paper will be provided immediately to the accepted participants.

5. CPSC will bear the costs, in accordance with practices and rates, the participant's discounted economy class return ticket, and nominal daily

subsistence allowance. Local expenditure towards hotel accommodation, meals, local transportation, field/institutional visits, will be sponsored by CTEVT under the implementing terms and condition.


6. You are requested to disseminate information regarding the programmes amongst the eligible Institutes/Departments/Faculty and send nomination of interested participants for consideration by the Ministry of Human Resource Development for final selection and recommendation to the CPSC, Manila.
