ORDER

Subject: Constitution of an Inter-Ministerial Committee to process the recommendations of Prof. Govardhan Mehta Committee constituted by this Ministry to consider the revision of pay scales etc. of the teaching faculty and Scientific/Design staff of centrally funded technical institutes.

The Ministry of Human Resource Development (Department of Higher Education) had constituted a Pay Review Committee under the chairmanship of Prof. G. Mehta, Chairman, NAAC vide this Department's order No.9-4/2007-TS.I dated 2.9.08 with the following terms of reference:

- (i) Review the implementation of the previous decisions of the Council of IITs/Government under the scheme of revision of pay scales approved for Faculty, Scientific/Design Staff and other Academic Staff of Central Technical Institutes under the Ministry of HRD and in the process to evaluate the extent to which the earlier recommendations in relation to coverage, pay scales, qualifications and experience, mode of recruitment, conditions of service etc., have been implemented;
- (ii) Examine the present structure of emoluments and conditions of service of Faculty, Scientific/Design Staff and other Academic Staff taking into account the total benefits available like pension, accommodation, medical facilities etc; and
- (iii) Make recommendations for revised pay scales, qualifications & experience, mode of recruitment, conditions of service etc., keeping in view the necessity of attracting and retaining the best talents.

2. The terms of reference were later revised to include the review of pay scales and service conditions of Teachers, Librarians and Physical Education Personnel of Degree level institutions and Teachers of Diploma level institutions. The Committee was to give separate reports for Centrally Funded institutions, Degree level institutions and Diploma level institutions.

3. The Pay Review Committee has submitted its report in respect of teaching faculty in Centrally Funded Technical Institutes. The Government has decided to constitute an Inter Ministerial Committee to examine the recommendations made by the Prof. Mehta Committee. The composition of the Empowered Committee is as follows:



5. The Inter Ministerial Committee may co-opt any person/expert to assist the Committee in its task. The Committee will submit its report to the government within 3 weeks from the date of its constitution.
