Subject: - **The Japan – East Asia Network of Exchange for Students and Youths Programme (JENESYS) – 2010.**

I am directed to say that 276 high school students from India will be visiting Japan in three batches during May – June 2010 under the Japan – East Asia Network of Exchange for Students and Youths Programme (JENESYS). A meeting was held on 31st March 2010 under the chairmanship of Shri S.C. Khuntia, Joint Secretary, Department of School Education & Literacy to select the candidates for visiting Japan under this programme. Representatives of Japanese Embassy and Japan International Cooperation Centre (JICE) attended the meeting. After scrutinizing the applications, 156 students have been selected for visiting Japan which is **annexed**. Minutes of the meeting and list of selected students are also available in the Ministry's website.

2. Following points may be noted for **immediate action**:

2.1 All the selected students themselves will have to obtain passport urgently and have to send the **original passport to the Travel agent authorized by the Japanese authority Le Passage To India Tours & Travels Pvt. Ltd. for arranging visas by 20.04.2010 positively.**

2.2 All organizations are advised to assist selected candidates not having passports to arrange the same through **Tatkal** scheme. **Original passports must not be sent to this Department.**

2.3. All those students who have not furnished 'Entry form' and 'Visa Application Form' **in original** must submit the same **immediately** to the travel agency, failing which it may not be possible to include them in the team. **Such candidates have been indicated in the column no. 6 & 7 of the candidate selected for the visit.**
