2. **It may be please be noted that this letter only accords administrative sanction for participation under the new Scheme, to enable the Polytechnics to start preparations & obtain all administrative clearances for implementing the new Scheme. No financial expenditure should be incurred under the new CDTP Scheme, by the above Polytechnics, until this Ministry issues financial sanction and releases necessary funds. Towards this end, the above Polytechnics may please be advised to take prompt action to refund the unspent grants and settle the accounts under the closed Scheme of Community Polytechnics, as already informed vide this Ministry’s letters.**

3. The *Salient Features Document* of the *Scheme of Community Development Through Polytechnics* may please be perused and downloaded from this Department’s website –

<http://www.education.nic.in/secondary.htm>, and clicking the following links therein (i) **Technical Education**; (ii) **Schemes** (iii) **Sub-Mission on Polytechnics**. To implement the aforementioned Scheme, the Polytechnics are eligible for the following maximum grants in aid from time to time :-

- (a) **One time Non Recurring Grants-in-aid of Rs 13.00 lakhs** for making the expenditure on non recurring items including equipment etc.
- (b) **Recurring Grants-in-aid upto a maximum of Rs 17.00 lakh per annum** for making recurring expenditure, including remuneration to the contractual Project Staff, stationary, consumables, technical material and other contingencies etc.

4. The Scheme should be implemented by the above polytechnics strictly in accordance with the *Salient Features Document* and the Ministry's instructions and Guidelines issued from time to time. The overall responsibility for implementation of the Scheme will rest with the Principal of the Polytechnic, who must ensure compliance of all applicable norms, guidelines & instructions.


5. The above Polytechnics are required to utilize the assets accumulated under the erstwhile *Scheme of Community Polytechnics*, to implement the new Scheme. The above Polytechnics should also maintain a Register of Assets listing, year-wise, the assets acquired under the old Scheme as well assets to be acquired under the new Scheme.

6. All project staff under this Scheme should be engaged only after the financial sanction is issued by this Ministry and funds are actually released to the Polytechnics. Such Project Staff should be engaged only as prescribed in the Scheme's Guidelines and the Principal of the Polytechnic must make clear to prospective contract employees at every stage of the recruitment, including in Public notices, Interview, contract etc. that the employment offered is purely temporary and under a project, approved for implementation on an annual basis.

7. Necessary financial sanction for the Grants-in-aid to be released during the year 2009-10, will be issued separately, after the above Polytechnics take further action for to refund the unspent grants and settle the accounts under the closed Scheme of Community Polytechnics.


